Summary:

10:00 Mr. Viskocil called and wanted to know what he needed to do to make changes in the license. Their only listed authorized user had left the employ of the company and all licensed material had been secured. I informed him that the licensee would need to amend its license and that licensed material would need to be secured until such time as the licensee received an approved amendment for a new authorized user. Mr. Viskocil stated he understood. The amendment would need to include the name of the individual, where he received training, over what time period was the training provided, what isotopes were used by the individual and in what amounts. Mr. Viskocil also stated that some researchers were looking into acquiring an Electron Capture Detector from a sister company. He described it as a Hewlett Packard model G1536A. Our database did not have such a model number so I referred him to the manufacturer. If the item was generally-licensed, they could receive it after notifying the manufacturer that the sister company was transferring the device to them. If specifically-licensed, then the license would need to be amended prior to their receiving it.

04/10/2008 Mr. Viskocil called back and informed me that he had spoken with the Radiation Safety Officer of Agilent Technologies (successor company of Hewlett Packard) who informed him that the gauge was generally-licensed.
