As discussed with you last week, we have decided to submit your request to be an authorized user of the Y-90 SirSpheres microspheres to NRC Headquarters for further review. Before doing so, we need the following additional information from you.

Please complete the enclosed NRC Form 313A(AUT) and especially note the areas I have highlighted which I believe pertains to your training and experience. We already have information previously provided concerning your Board Certifications and will submit this along with the completed enclosed form. The form needs to be signed by an Authorized User physician ("Preceptor Attestation") who can verify the completion of your training and experience. Please return the form directly to me at 5803 Pine Hollow Road, Clayton, CA 94517. I will then combine it with other documents previously submitted and forward everything to NRC Headquarters. I anticipate there will be a review of this information by both NRC staff and the NRC's Advisory Committee on the Medical Uses of Isotopes (ACMUI). The NRC staff are gathering other similar requests to be reviewed and this may take several months to complete. We will inform you of the review and decision when it becomes available.
