I would like to add one new device to condition 11 of the materials license 29-28620-02G. The device is the "Multi-Mode Threat Detector" or "MMTD".

In addition, I would also like to add the "Multi-Mode Threat Detector" ("MMTD") to paragraph 9.A of the materials license 29-28620-01.

The MMTD is a hardened version of the Sabre 4000, which was previously listed on these licenses. The MMTD is designed for use in severe environmental conditions. The engineering details of this product have been submitted to the NRC for addition to the Smiths Detection registry of radioactive sealed sources and devices certificate (NR-0163-D-101-G). The review of this information has been completed and the device has been added to the registry as of March 28, 2008.
