This letter is written to inform you and request your permission prior to transfer of control of the radioactive materials license from Papastavros' Associates Medical Imaging to Delaware Imaging Partners, Inc. Effective March 14, 2008, Delaware Imaging Partners, Inc. acquired the assets of Papastavros' Associates Medical Imaging. The facilities will continue to comply with all regulatory requirements and conditions of the current NRC radioactive material license No. 07-16529-01.


As required by 10 CFR 30.34 and 10 CFR 35.14, we are providing you with information regarding our intentions at the current Papastavros' Associates facilities which are included in our NRC radioactive material license:

- Radioactive materials will continue to be possessed, used and controlled by the licensed facilities;
- All radioactive materials will be properly handled and secured;
- Persons using these materials (authorized users and nuclear medicine technologists) are competent and committed to using radiological controls;
- The chain of custody established for responsibility for final disposal of radioactive materials includes nuclear medicine technologists, the Radiation Safety Officer, and licensee management.

There are planned changes for equipment at the Augustine Cut-off facility, including the purchase of new nuclear medicine gamma cameras, installation of a permanent PET-CT unit, and renovation of the nuclear medicine department. Details regarding these facility changes will be provided to you as new radiation area survey and contamination survey locations are identified on proposed floor plans. As per existing license conditions, current equipment will continue to be used to assure proper use, possession, storage, waste disposal, accurate patient dosage administration, and wipe test quantification. We will request amendments to our radioactive material license as required.
