(U.S.A.), Inc. dated April 10, 2008, recently received by the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC), requesting Amendment No. 1 to export license XSNM3480 for the export of low-enriched uranium (LEU) for ultimate use as fuel in the Kashiwazaki-Kariwa Unit 7 nuclear reactor in Japan. The purpose of the Amendment is to change both the first and last shipping dates of the export, thus, extending the expiration date from July 31, 2008 to July 31, 2011.

Since no other changes to the terms and conditions of the existing license are requested, we intend to issue this minor amendment after the 30-day time period allotted for public review expires and it is determined that applicable export license criteria are met.
