**On October 19, 2007, Louisiana Energy Services, L.P. ("LES") submitted a License Amendment Request requesting an Indirect Transfer of the License from a Limited Partnership to a Limited Liability Company. On April 3, 2008 the NRC issued a letter, Safety Evaluation Report and Order approving the Amendment Request. In the Order LES was directed to inform the NRC in writing at least one business day prior to converting itself into a Limited Liability Company. LES anticipates that it will execute the necessary documents to request the conversion on Friday, April 25, 2008, and then overnight them to the State of Delaware. LES further anticipates that the State of Delaware will accept the documents for filing and therefore effectuate the conversion on Monday April 28, 2008. Accordingly, LES anticipates converting from a limited partnership to a limited liability company, pursuant to the approved license amendment, on Monday, April 28, 2008..**
