(NOTE: This will be used as the Documents Title in ADAMS)Summary: I spoke with Mr. Peterson about the financial assurance submission dated March 18, 2008. He indicated that he was not the person to speak with as he did not have anything to do with the financial matters of the institution. Mr. Last handles those matters and Mr. Last would contact him if there were any technical matters to needed to be taken care of.

I spoke with Mr. Last about the financial assurance submittal. I informed him that financial assurance is only required for those isotopes with a half-life of 120 days or more. Three of the isotopes listed in the Certification of Financial Assurance did not meet this criteria, i.e., P-32, P-33 and S-35, and could be removed. Also, the current Statement of Intent dated May 14, 2001, is still for \$150,000 and needs to be updated. Mr. Last informed me that John F. Anderson is no longer the Director and the new Director would sign the Statement of Intent.
