SUBJECT: SUMMARY OF THE PUBLIC SCOPING MEETINGS TO
SUPPORT THE REVIEW OF THE BELLEFONTE NUCLEAR
PLANT, UNITS 3 AND 4 COMBINED LICENSE APPLICATION
(TAC NO. RB9336)

On Thursday, April 3, 2008, members of the Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) staff held two public environmental scoping meetings in Scottsboro, Alabama in support of the staff's review of the Bellefonte Nuclear Plant, Units 3 and 4 combined licenses (COL) application. Formal presentations were made by James Lyons and Mallecia Hood of the NRC staff. Enclosure 1 is the official corrected transcript recorded at the afternoon meeting. Enclosure 2 is the corrected transcript recorded at the evening meeting. Enclosure 3 includes copies of slides presented at the meeting. Enclosure 4 is the open house handout and Enclosure 5 provides the names and accession numbers of the public that provided comments during the public scoping meeting. During each meeting, the NRC staff presentation outlined:

- 1) the overall licensing process under 10 CFR Part 52,
- 2) provided a description of the National Environmental Policy Act of 1969 (NEPA) review process,
- 3) discussed the environmental requirements outlined in 10 CFR Part 51, and
- 4) addressed how these requirements would be implemented during the Bellefonte Nuclear Plant, Units 3 and 4 COL review.
