GE-Hitachi Nuclear Energy Americans, LLC. (GEH) in Sunol, CA (known as Vallecitos Nuclear Center) has evaluated our emergency planning and response actions to address an imminent threat per your request. As we discussed during our phone meeting on March 12th, 2008, our current Emergency Procedures contain appropriate actions to be taken in response to a postulated imminent security related threat. Responses to a variety of events have been identified and the site emergency support infrastructure, including the notification and mobilization of off-site agencies, has been provided.

These preparations include:

- 1) Trained emergency response personnel and adequate communication equipment to receive an imminent threat notification, activate the site emergency organization and coordinate as necessary with offsite agencies.
- 2) A trained Emergency Organization to respond to a range of postulated security compromise threats including event classification, notification and appropriate emergency response measures.
- 3) Response coordination with off-site local service support and other government agencies.
- 4) Periodic drills and exercises that test the timing and effectiveness of site emergency plans, facilities, equipment and personnel.
