- Licensee Planning Base:
  - Discusses site specific elements of the licensee physical protection program and protective strategy as related to contingency response.
  - Identifies elements that must be included in the SCP.
  - Open for Discussion

# **Draft Regulatory Guide-5016**

## **Nuclear Power Plant Safeguards**

### **Contingency Plans**

- **Responsibility Matrix:**
  - Outlines actions and objectives in response to the events in the Generic Planning Base.
  - Identifies specific responsibilities for actions to be performed in response to these events.
  - Describes information under this section required for inclusion in the SCP and information that can be included in procedures.
  - Open for Discussion

- Implementing Procedures:
  - Identifies the requirement to establish implementing procedures to support the SCP.
  - Describes context of implementing procedures.
