SUBJECT: SUMMARY OF THE PUBLIC MEETINGS FOR THE ENVIRONMENTAL
SCOPING PROCESS TO SUPPORT REVIEW OF THE CALVERT
CLIFFS, UNIT 3, COMBINED LICENSE APPLICATION (TAC NO.

On Wednesday, March 19, 2008, members of the Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) staff held two public environmental scoping meetings in Solomon's, Maryland, in support of the staff's review of the Calvert Cliffs combined License (COL) application. Formal presentations were made by James Lyons and Thomas Fredrichs of the NRC staff. Enclosure 1 is the transcript recorded at the afternoon meeting. Enclosure 2 is the transcript recorded at the evening meeting. In Enclosure 3 are copies of slides presented at the meeting. Enclosure 4 is the open house handout and Enclosure 5 is the written statements provided to the NRC staff during the public meeting comment period. Enclosure 6 is a list of meeting attendees.

The purpose of the meetings were to provide the public with an opportunity to participate in the environmental scoping process by providing comments on any issues the public felt the NRC staff should consider while preparing an environmental impact statement (EIS) for the Calvert Cliffs COL application. During each meeting the NRC staff presentation outlined:

- 1) the overall licensing process under 10 CFR Part 52;
- 2) provided a description of the National Environmental Policy Act of 1969 (NEPA) review process;
- 3) discussed the environmental requirements outlined in 10 CFR Part 51; and
- 4) addressed how these requirements would be implemented during the Calvert Cliffs COL review.
