
I am absolutely against Energy Solutions accepting 20,000 tons of radio active waste from Italy.

There are many deserted land areas on the Euro/Asian continents where they should handle their own waste. Their willingness to ship 20,000 tons across an entire ocean only further proves the toxicity that they do not want in their backyard. If we set a precedent with the Italian waste, we open the door to more shipments from the world.

I live in Salt Lake City. Last week we had two wind storms that came from the west desert (Energy Solutions location), that were so dense they obscured the mountains one-mile from my home. Now I know how "safe" this site is supposed to be. But I also remember how "safe" the government testing was in Nevada, and the proof of time. I also know that Salt Lake is home to a major earthquake fault on the east, that Wells, Nevada just experienced an earthquake on the west, and that an earthquake fault was discovered this year in Tooele only miles from Energy Solutions.

I am concerned for my children and grandchildren. Please do not allow radio active material of any kind to be imported to Utah or any other location in the United States. The price is too high - and those that profit, do so at the expense of our lives!
