So that I may have an official document to reference, please verify, by replying to this email that the following information you provided that will be included in the environmental assessment the Nuclear Regulatory Commission is preparing for Global Nuclear Fuel-Americas' license renewal application is correct:

New Hanover County Projected Planning

- 1) Project - I-140 is a new interstate along the southern border of the site
Time frame - Current and over the next 5-10 yrs
Description -The intersection of I-140 and Castle Hayne Rd. is a "hot spot" that is currently experiencing and will continue to experience commercial, industrial, and residential growth.
- 2) Project - Water and sewer services to be provided across the Cape Fear River from GNF-A
Time frame - Within 5 years
Description - New Hanover County and adjacent Pender County have plans in the works to provide these services in order to encourage industrial growth in this area.

3) Project - Rail Line Extension

Time frame - Within 10 years

Description - DOT has obtained a right-of-way permit to extend the rail line near GNF-A to the Raleigh/Durham area. This extension will likely lead to growth in the area.

4) Project - Main Port to move to Southport

Time frame - Within 10-20 years

Description - The land has already been purchased, however permits are still needed for this expansion. This port opening will lead to more transportation brokerage, warehousing, etc. in the area.

5) Project - Public Groundwater System

Time frame - Current

Description - First public groundwater system
