2) Physical Description

This shipment consists of 8 x 30B Enriched UF6 Cylinders in sealed overpacks on 2 x 20' flatrack. RADIOACTIVE MATERIAL, URANIUM HEXAFLUORIDE, FISSILE. Total net weight of U is 1,539.5 kgs. The net weight of U-235 is 76.98 kgs.

3) Transportation and Route Schedule

The ocean transportation from Port of Portsmouth, VA to Gothenburg, Sweden will be the responsibility of Atlantic Container Line. The inland transportation from the Port of Portsmouth to Columbia, SC will be the responsibility of Westinghouse Electric Corporation.
