The Commission discussed proposed letters to Ms. Goler Teal Butcher of White, Fine and Verville (Counselors at Law), Mr. O.S. Heistand of Morgan, Lewis, and Bockius (Counselors at Law), and Mr. Louis V. Nosenzo, Deputy Assistant Secretary, Bureau of Oceans and International Environment and Scientific Affairs, Department of State. The proposed letters would inform the recipients of the postponement of the Commission's decision on the subject export license and the petition to intervene filed on behalf of Congressman Diggs, et al., pending receipt from the Executive Branch of its final views on this matter.

The Commission approved the proposed letters, subject to deletion of the second paragraph of the letter to Mr. Nosenzo.
