This is a reply to your January 4, 2008 letter requesting the Waccamaw Siouan Tribe's input on identification of Tribal historic sites or culture resources within the GNF-A site situated on a 1,664-acre tract of land located on Highway 133 and approximately six miles north of the city of Wilmington, North Carolina in New Hano-ver County.

The Waccamaw Siouan Tribe has reviewed the documents you sent on the project area and we are unaware of any traditional religious or cultural significance to the tribe at this location however this does not mean that this area does not contain any Tribal artifact and other Tribal significance items. We recommend that you notify the Tribe if any American Indian artifacts or other items of culture significance are found on or adjacent to this site.
