In accordance with NRC Regulatory Issue Summary 2007-22, we request amendment to our byproduct materials license #13-00418-02 to include the accelerator produced materials that will now be considered byproduct materials under the new guidelines. We request that gallium-67, Thallium-201, iodine-123 and indium-111 radiopharmaceuticals be included on our license. Also we possess Co-57 sealed sources as calibration and reference sources. These are less than the 10 CFR 35.65 limit of 30 millicuries. We do not use PET radiopharmaceuticals at this hospital.

Also please note that the name of this facility has been changed to St Joseph Hospital and has not been a Medical Center in a number of years.


