On July 28, 2005, the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) staff met with Nuclear Fuel Services (NFS) at NRC Headquarters. The purpose of the closed meeting was to discuss a tentative project that NFS is pursuing [REDACTED]. The project will involve NFS taking possession and reprocessing radioactive material from a laboratory [REDACTED]. NFS has plans to arrange for a single shipment by the end of 2005, and has determined that no license amendment will be required for shipping, receiving or storing this material.
