This letter and the enclosed NRC Form 591M refer to the inspection conducted September 25, 2007, to May 14, 2008, at your facility in Bismarck North Dakota. This inspection was an examination of activities conducted under the authority of Byproduct Materials License 33-29238-01 as they relate to safety and compliance with the Commission's rules and regulations and with the conditions of the license. At the conclusion of the inspection, a preliminary exit briefing to discuss the inspection findings was conducted with you. A final exit briefing was conducted telephonically with Ms. June Schaan on May 14, 2008. We recognize that there has been considerable delay between the date of the onsite inspection and the date of the final telephonic exit. This delay was due, in part, to careful consideration of the inspection findings and additional information provided by you both written and verbally, in order for us to make an informed decision as to the adequacy of your program.

Within the scope of this inspection, no violations were identified; therefore, no response to this letter or the enclosed NRC Form 591M is required.
