Summary: 14:15 I left a message with the receptionist for Mr. Nacamuli to call me back after being told that he was out of the office but expected back.

I explained that this was a courtesy phone call and that a review of available records indicated that, as of this date, no renewal application had been received by the Region requesting renewal of their license. Mr. Nacamuli stated that it was his brother's (i.e., Robert's) responsibility to complete such applications. He would check with him to see if it was completed. I informed Mr. Nacamuli that there was no fee involved for a renewal but if the license was allowed to expire, then the gauges would need to be secured and not used until such time as a new license was issued. A new license would require a fee and would hold up his business, a renewal application would be considered timely filed if received prior to May 31st and the business would not be interrupted. Mr. Nacamuli stated that his brother would get back to me if he had any questions.
