SUBJECT: NOTIFICATION OF UPCOMING MEETING

Dear \_\_\_\_\_:

Each year, the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) conducts an integrated assessment of nuclear power plant performance. This assessment is based upon the risk significance of the inspection findings by the NRC's resident and region-based inspectors and the insights gained from the licensee-provided performance indicators. The results are then communicated with the public through a public meeting held in the vicinity of each nuclear power plant. Nationally, plants with significant performance shortcomings are reviewed by the NRC's senior management and discussed with the Commission in a public meeting in Rockville, Maryland.

We have completed the assessments associated with the 2008 inspections and performance indicators for the Callaway Plant. The results can be found on the NRC web site at [http://www.nrc.gov/NRR/OVERSIGHT/ASSESS/CALL/call\\_chart.html](http://www.nrc.gov/NRR/OVERSIGHT/ASSESS/CALL/call_chart.html). We have also scheduled a public meeting to discuss the results. The meeting for the Callaway Plant is scheduled for 6:30 p.m. (CDT), May 29, 2007 at Burton Business Building, Classroom 6, on the William Woods University campus in Fulton, Missouri.

In conjunction with this meeting, we are offering all attendees an opportunity to meet separately with an NRC Region IV manager and myself, the NRC Senior Resident Inspector at the Callaway Plant, immediately following the public meeting. This opportunity is intended to provide you a forum to ask any questions which you may have, and to let you meet personally the NRC personnel with whom you would interface in the event of an emergency at the nuclear power plant.

In accordance with 10 CFR 2.390 of the NRC's "Rules of Practice," a copy of this letter will be made available electronically for public inspection in the Publicly Available Records (PARS) component of NRC's document system (ADAMS). ADAMS is accessible from the NRC Web site at <http://www.nrc.gov/reading-rm.html> (the Public Electronic Reading Room). This letter will also be available online at <http://www.nrc.gov/public-involve/public-meetings/index.cfm>.
