BWXT TECHNOLOGIES, INC.'S COMPLIANCE WITH [REDACTED]

Dear Ms. Morrell:

Based on the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission's (NRC's) review and inspection, the staff has determined that BWXT Technologies, Inc. (BWXT) is in compliance with the reporting requirements of the February 2003 [REDACTED] Order. BWXT appropriately concluded that it has no [REDACTED], and has adequately implemented the Order requirements. A brief summary of activities that supported this determination follows.

On February 6, 2003, the NRC issued an Order directing BWXT to implement the [REDACTED] [REDACTED] at its facility. By letters dated February 26, and August 13, 2003, BWXT submitted its response to the Order. By letter dated August 13, 2003, BWXT announced that it completed the [REDACTED] required by the Order.

The NRC performed an inspection at BWXT, and your actions in this matter, to determine compliance with the [REDACTED] Order. Inspection Report No. 70-27/2006-010, dated March 31, 2006, documented that there were no violations identified during the inspection.

Notwithstanding any provisions of the Commission's regulations to the contrary, all [REDACTED] implemented, or actions taken in response to the [REDACTED] requirements, shall be maintained until the Commission orders otherwise, or until the Commission explicitly modifies its regulations, and states in modifying its regulations, that the revisions are to supercede the [REDACTED] Order. The implemented [REDACTED] or actions taken are subject to further inspection, to verify that the [REDACTED] requirements are maintained.

On September 18, 2006, we held a teleconference with BWXT, and provided a status of NRC's actions in this matter.
