
Dear Ms. Moore:

We have received your submittal of your revised Physical Protection Plan, Site Security Training Plan and Safeguards Plan for Materials License SNM-124 transmitted by letter dated April 29, 2004. The staff has completed an initial acceptance review of the NFS physical protection, and training and qualification plans. The and training and qualification plans meet the staff's initial acceptance criteria of format, content and commitment. However, the submitted physical protection plan does not meet the initial acceptance criteria and we ask that you make revisions to the plan and submit for staff review and approval by June 18, 2004.

The submitted plan does not contain commitments identified in NUREG-1322, "Acceptance Criteria for the Evaluation of Category-1 Fuel Cycle Facility Physical Security Plans." Ensure that the revised plan clearly and specifically identifies each Commission requirement that is intended to be satisfied by each provision of the plan. Additionally, remove redundancies, ensure that commitments are in the appropriate section, and remove extraneous material that is not commitment related. For further information please refer to Attachment 1, "Staff Guiding Principles And Criteria For Reviewing Revised Physical Security Plans, Safeguards

And Training and Qualification Plans," of NRC letter dated November 13, 2003, "Request for Input to Guidance," (ADAMS Accession Number ML033230599).

Please note that an initial acceptance review is not an approval to begin operations with the plans. Final NRC approval to utilize the submitted plans will come after completion of the iterative review process, completion of a safeguards evaluation report, and issuance of a license condition.
