I am responding to your letters dated July 14 and October 18, 2006, which submitted Revision 5 to your Physical Protection Plan for Category I High-Enriched Uranium. We have completed our review of the changes, and find them acceptable. Specifically, we agree that the changes do not decrease the effectiveness of the physical security program at Nuclear Fuel Services, Inc., and were properly submitted under 10 CFR Part 70.32(e). Condition S-1 of your license shall be revised in a future license amendment to include the date of October 18, 2006, which replaced Revision 5 in its entirety.

Upon receipt of the subject submittal, we assigned this action Technical Assignment Control (TAC) number L31966. This letter accepts the changes, therefore, TAC L31966 is closed.
