Dear Mr. May:

Please find enclosed Amendment No. 23 terminating License No. 01-02861-05 as requested by your letter dated April 26, 2005. This termination is being issued in accordance with the requirements of the applicable NRC License Termination Rule (10 CFR 30.36, 10 CFR 40.42, and 10 CFR 70.38). The Safety Evaluation Report (SER) that supports license termination is enclosed. All facilities previously used for licensed activities may be released for unrestricted use.

An Environmental Assessment (EA) and Finding Of No Significant Impact (FONSI) was published in the Federal Register on January 4, 2001, (66 FR 812-815), at the initiation of decommissioning activities, and an EA and FONSI was published in the Federal Register on March 7, 2007, (72 FR 10262-64) in support of this license termination.

Concurrent with this action, we are voiding the licensing action for your financial assurance dated March 7, 2005, Control Number 136898. Your Statement of Intent is for both locations of use for the U.S. Army Chemical School, the previous location at Fort McClellan in Alabama and the current location in Missouri. This action terminates the license for the Alabama location, and financial assurance is no longer required for that location. You should amend your Statement of Intent to address only the Missouri location of use. Please be advised that you should send this amendment to the Region III NRC Office in Lisle, Illinois.
