Specifically, we agree that the changes do not decrease the effectiveness of the physical security program at Nuclear Fuel Services, Inc. In addition, we conclude that your response is acceptable to our letter dated February 8, 2006, requesting an immediate change in your physical protection program to address changes in the [REDACTED]. Condition S-1 of your license shall be revised in a future license amendment to include the date of this submittal.
