In Reference 1, Detroit Edison informed the Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) of its intent to prepare an application for a Combined License (COL) for a new nuclear power plant being considered for construction and operation at the Fermi nuclear plant site in Newport, Michigan and provided the NRC with its reactor technology selection. At that time, Detroit Edison requested that the reactor technology selection be withheld from public disclosure in accordance with 10 CFR 2.390.


The purpose of this letter is to inform the NRC that there is no longer a need to withhold this information from public disclosure. The Detroit Edison COL application is being developed based on the General Electric Hitachi Economic Simplified Boiling Water Reactor (ESBWR).
