I have looked through the Branch 4 allegation information on the G drive and compared the information in the appropriate allegation files against the assertions in RI-2007-A-0040

here are my results:

fear of retaliation against security guards was previously investigated as part of allegations [redacted] and was not substantiated

Sleeping in the BREs was looked at as part of allegation [redacted] and was not substantiated

security force overtime and fatigue issues were reviewed as part of allegations [redacted] and not substantiated

The letter is inconsistent with itself. On the first page, in third paragraph it states "The officers ... want to report that on numerous occasions they have witnessed security officers in Bullet Resistant Enclosure (BRE) towers sleeping ..." and in suggestion 4 on page 2 states "They recline in a chair or lie on the floor, out of sight while being protected from discovery by sitting or lying on the BRE hatch door." These two statements can not both be true.

Since the individual states that the NRC is aware of guards sleeping and doesn't want to find out about it, we need to refer this assertion of wrongdoing to the Inspector General.

Since the individual further states "I do not want the NRC or it's [sic] agents to contact me in any manner, it would appear appropriate to close this allegation after referral to OIG."
