All,

This message is being sent to inform NRR, the regions, NMSS and FSME that NSIR has the approval to develop a Generic Communication that will affect NRC-Licensed Facilities. This generic communication is being developed to address a number of recent events that have occurred at NRC-licensed facilities that have a direct effect on common defense and security. NSIR will provide guidance on the implementation of existing security requirements regarding the issue.

The generic communication will address to inattentive security officer issues at several facilities notably the recent occurrence at Indian Point, and likely Peach Bottom, that add to a longer list of examples over several years. We've been asked to make every effort to issue it before the October 3 EPW oversight hearing as the recent publicity makes it a good candidate issue to be raised there.
