Summary of the April 15, 2008, Meeting of the
Savannah River Site Citizens Advisory Board Waste Management Committee

Purpose: The purpose of this meeting was to inform the Committee of the status of the implementation of Section 3116 of the Ronald W. Reagan National Defense Authorization Act for Fiscal Year 2005 at the Savannah River Site.

Discussion:

This was a meeting of the Savannah River Site Citizen's Advisory Board Waste Management Committee at which State and Federal agencies had been invited to participate. Participating agencies included the South Carolina Department of Health and Environmental Control (SCDHEC), Region 4 of the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA Region 4), the Department of Energy (DOE), and the Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC). The agenda for the meeting included opening remarks by both DOE and NRC staff, and five presentations by DOE's Office of Environmental Management, NRC staff, DOE's Savannah River Operations Office, SCDHEC, and EPA Region 4. Following the presentations, the Committee and members of the public were afforded an opportunity to ask questions of a panel comprised of representatives of all four agencies. An agenda for the meeting is provided as Enclosure 1.

DOE's Office of Environmental Management, NRC staff, and DOE's Savannah River Operations Office chose to prepare slides to accompany their remarks. These slides are provided as Enclosures 3, 4 and 5, respectively. Representatives of SCDHEC and EPA Region 4 chose not to use slides.

The Committee notes in its summary (Enclosure 2) that "it would like to remain informed of the public and scoping meeting activities and results, and kept apprised of the progress of cleaning and achieving tank closure at SRS. All briefings were well-received. No actions or recommendations evolved from the meeting discussions."
