The Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) is pleased that you have agreed to participate in a Commission meeting on reactor fire protection issues, Thursday, July 17, 2008. Your presentation at the Commission meeting should be based on the assumption that Commissioners are familiar with the content of your written material. Please plan your oral presentation for 5 minutes or less, discussing the important points on which you wish to focus the Commission's attention.

The White Flint Metro Station is on the Red Line of the Washington area subway system. The trip from Metro Center takes about 45 minutes. Reserved visitor parking for Commission guests is available.
