## Dear Mr. McCann:

This letter transmits to the Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) the referenced informational documents for review as requested by NRC staff in support of the pending June 2008 inspection.

The results obtained from the radiological surveys of Buildings 110, 230 and 231 are provided in Volume 1 of the "Hematite Supplemental Characterization Report". The portions of Volume 1 that are most closely associated with these building surveys can be found in Section 3.0, Instrumentation; Section 4.0, Survey Design; Section 6.0, Building Data Collection and Results, and in Section 7.0, Summary and Conclusions. The documentation associated with each of the individual survey packages and the individual radiological measurement results are provided in Appendix A, Survey Packages and Results by Survey Area. The instrument calibration records and operability checks can be found in Appendix B, Instrument Calibration and Source Check Data.

Additionally, the laboratory analytical reports for the samples obtained from the openings of building drains can be found in Volume 2 of the "Hematite Supplemental Characterization Report", Appendix C, Soil and Miscellaneous Sample Analytical Results.
