My name is Chris Dunsmore and I am a resident of Salt Lake City. I am writing in order to voice my opinion concerning EnergySolutions' recent request to import 20,000 tons of Italian nuclear waste into the U.S. In the past I have been quietly upset about the dealings of EnergySolutions but I now wish to speak up and urge the Nuclear Regulatory Commission to deny this company's request. I understand that this request is much larger than any import license previously granted by the Commission and would set a dangerous precedent for this country's policies for handling nuclear waste.

By granting this request we may be allowing the U.S. to become the world's nuclear waste dump, when our own low-level waste disposal capacity remains uncertain. If we continue to accept other countries' nuclear waste we will be putting pressure on existing disposal sites to expand and will be creating a need for more sites to open. Most importantly, this creates a great risk to public health and safety. Not only do these sites threaten the health of the surrounding population, transportation of waste through our cities and towns will present unacceptable health risks to a much larger portion of the population. Furthermore, maintaining more sites will put strain on our national defense and security as the need to safeguard these sites increases.

In its application EnergySolutions states that "the sources of this material are not fully known" and that some of the waste may be above allowable contamination for processing and disposal in Utah. The unclear nature and the hazards that may result from this import should force the Commission to deny this request.

I urge the Commission to reject EnergySolutions' application for these reasons and for the sake of our state. We must consider that our health and safety is at stake, and the well being of future generations is at stake. Thank you.
