Dear Dr. Zickgraf:

Enclosed is Amendment No. 63 to your NRC Material License No. 13-15882-01 in accordance with your request. Please note that the changes made to your license are printed in **bold** font.

Please review the enclosed document carefully and be sure that you understand all conditions. If there are any errors or questions, please notify the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission, Region III office at (630) 829-9887 so that we can provide appropriate corrections and answers. If you have any questions concerning this amendment please contact me at either (630) 829-9841 or (800) 522-3025.

1. **At this time please specify the possession limit you want for materials listed in Subitem No. 8.I. We must now review license applications and prepare license documents in accordance with this RIS and the requested information is necessary to complete that review. You may reference this as "additional information to control number 316937" and mark it to my attention.**

**Please note that I requested this information in my letter to you dated on or about March 6, 2008, but that you have not responded as yet.**

**Please submit this information within 30 days of the date of this letter or call me to arrange an alternative response date.**

2. **At this time I was unable to delete your authorization for materials in Subitem Nos. 6 through 9. H., as it appeared on Amendment No. 62, because the information provided in your letter dated April 2, 2008, was insufficient to complete our review.**

**Please submit a copy of acknowledgments of receipt from the appropriate vendors who took possession of your final source. The acknowledgments of receipt must show that the vendors received your last active sources and devices and were appropriately licensed to take possession of these sources/device. They must be signed and dated appropriately.**

**10 CFR 30.41 and 30.51 require this information and we must review it before we can amend your license to remove these authorizations from your license. Your vendors should have sent this information to you automatically when you returned the last sources/devices.**

**Please note that bills of lading and shipping papers only describe that materials were prepared for shipment. They do not confirm that materials were transferred to appropriately licensed recipients.**

**Please also provide copies of the most recent leak tests for each of the sealed sources in question. For the intravascular brachytherapy sealed source, we are only interested in the final sealed source you possessed and transferred.**

- 3. At this time I deleted Condition Nos. 15, 18 and 20, as they appeared on Amendment No. 62, because they no longer apply to your licensed program.**

NRC's Regulatory Issue Summary (RIS) 2005-31 provides criteria to identify security-related sensitive information and guidance for handling and marking of such documents. This ensures that potentially sensitive information is not made publicly available through ADAMS, the NRC's electronic document system.

Pursuant to NRC's RIS 2005-31 and in accordance with 10 CFR 2.390, the enclosed license document is exempt from public disclosure because its disclosure to unauthorized individuals could present a security vulnerability.

You will be periodically inspected by NRC. Failure to conduct your program in accordance with NRC regulations, license conditions, and representations made in your license application and supplemental correspondence with NRC will result in enforcement action against you. This could include issuance of a notice of violation, or imposition of a civil penalty, or an order suspending, modifying or revoking your license as specified in the General Statement of Policy and Procedure for NRC Enforcement Actions.
