Insert personal comments here: : TO: Secretary of the US Nuclear Regulatory Commission,

I am writing with some urgency to ask you to prevent the dangerous precedent of importing foreign nuclear waste. You've been asked to approve a request by EnergySolutions to import over 20,000 tons of Italian nuclear waste. Not only is this single request many times larger than ALL previously approved import licenses, but, if approved, will begin a devastating pattern of accepting other countries nuclear waste.

Waste disposal, because of it's extremely long term impacts, requires thoughtful policy. As I've examined the world wide approach to nuclear waste disposal, I've seen every free country struggle to balance their home population's concern about the direct human health and longer term environmental impacts of nuclear waste disposal, with the real problem of where to store waste safely. The US has this problem already. And, it will only become thornier, as more military sites and power plants are decommissioned. The Italian waste is the first part of a multi-stage import plan that will render the US the dumping ground for most of Europe, exacerbating an existing domestic problem. The NRC must prevent this.

The regulatory responsibility of the NRC is critical to the protection of the health, safety and welfare of the American people, now threatened by the combined need of Italy to dispose of radioactive material, and the financial appetite of a company with no public responsibility. I urge you to exercise the full extent of your power to protect the United States from becoming the waste repository for the rest of the world.

Please reject the application submitted by EnergySolutions. Thank you.
