SUBJECT: ALLEGATION PROGRAM – 2007 ANNUAL TRENDS REPORT

In accordance with Management Directive 8.8, "Management of Allegations," dated February 4, 1999, the Agency Allegation Advisor must provide to the Executive Director for Operations an independent annual report analyzing allegation trends. A copy of the annual trends report for calendar year 2007 is enclosed.

The report analyzes national, regional, and site-specific trends in allegation data. The analyses provide insights into the safety conscious work environment at several reactor sites. The report summarizes several staff activities involving the Allegation Program and related policies, including internal lessons learned reviews regarding the handling of allegations in 2007 regarding inattentive security officers at the Peach Bottom Atomic Power Station and the resulting proposed enhancements to the allegation process. In addition to the staff's internal reviews, the Office of the Inspector General is conducting an investigation into this matter that may yield further enhancements for consideration. In addition, the staff plans to engage external stakeholders regarding aspects of the process enhancements. Commission and Allegation Program policy and guidance documents will document the outcome of these activities.
