Re.: EnergySolutions' license application to import Italian waste.

I am writing to you as a resident of East Tennessee. My wife, my family and her family all live down wind from the Bear Creek facility. With this in mind I <u>strongly support</u> the application to import the waste material from Italy. No job is worth the lives and health of your family. If I did not know that the Bear Creek Operations functioned at the highest level of preemptive safety I would not work here, I would not live here.

This work is nothing new for Bear Creek. It is the same work that we do day in and out with both domestic and Canadian waste. We have just received notification that we are the first company in East Tennessee to receive the Tennessee OSHA Voluntary Protection Program VPP Star Status. We did so while involved with nuclear energy and nuclear waste. We live and breathe safety here. I and the rest of the workers would have it no other way. OSHA will now use our safety program as an example to other business in the region on how to work safely.

The capacity argument is a smokescreen. Our facility In Clive, Utah has ample room for this and more. Please do not allow the fears and ignorance of a few dissuade you from making a sound and prudent decision on behalf of the American people.

I strongly urge the Commission to approve the license request.
