## Concept of the Operation:

This provides an overview of the Ginna\* and Nine Mile Point (NMP) alternative site visit combined with the Nine Mile Point T-1 pre-application visit. Except for the Cultural and Socioeconomics/Environmental Justice disciplines it spans the time period from 4 May to 1200 hrs on 7 May 2008. It involves sites adjoining two separate operating nuclear plants on Lake Ontario in the State of New York. In order to minimize staff and travel resources the two activities, the alternate site visit for Calvert Cliffs' to Ginna and NMP are combined with the NMP T-1 pre-application visit. With the exception of the Socioeconomics and Environmental Justice and Cultural reviewers, after 1200 hrs on Wednesday personnel will travel home, to the Fermi T-1, or the Levy C-3. Any deviations by personnel to the proposed activities need to be cleared with the Readiness Team Manager (M. Masnik) prior to the event.

### 4 May 08 Sunday

Those individuals that will be participating in the Ginna and NMP alternate site visits will travel on Sunday 4 May 08. Participants in the Ginna alternate site visit are listed on the personnel roster (attachment A under Ginna). Lodging for the night of 4 May 08 will be at the Doubletree Hotel, Rochester, 1111 Jefferson Road, Rochester, NY (585-475-1510). Suggest those that are attending the Ginna alternative site visit also fly in and out of Syracuse. It is only about 1.25 hrs by car to the Rochester Doubletree from the Syracuse Airport. Adjust flights so that you are available to meet at 1900 hrs on 4 May 08 in the motel lobby. Directions to the Rochester Doubletree are found in Attachment B.

### 5 May 08 Monday

All personnel will depart the Rochester Doubletree at 0745 hrs on 5 May 08 for travel to Ginna Site. Travel to the Ginna site is by rental car. Directions to the Ginna Site from the Hotel are found in Attachment B. We will meet in the Conference Room in the training center at 0830 hrs outside the protected area of the R. E. Ginna Nuclear Power Plant. No badging will be needed. A copy of the schedule for the Ginna visit is found in attachment C. After a short meeting in the conference room we will travel to the nearby alternative sites. It is expected that our visit to the Ginna site will be completed by 1100 hrs. There are no arrangements for a noon meal. All personnel except D. Mussatti and T. Seacrest will then travel to Oswego, NY. D. Mussatti and T. Seacrest will spend a portion of the afternoon reconnoitering the Ginna environs and then travel to Oswego late in the afternoon. Travel to Oswego, NY will be by rental cars. Directions are found in Appendix B

Additional members of the NMP C-1 team (see attachment A) will travel to Oswego, NY. on Monday 5 May 08. Lodging for all personnel attending the NMP visit will be at the Captains Quarters, 26 E First Street, Oswego, NY (315-342-4040). Directions from Syracuse Airport to Captain's Quarters are found in Attachment B. All personnel (except D. Mussatti and T. Seacrest by prior arrangement) are to be present at a short meeting in the lobby of the Captain's Quarters at 1900 hrs on 5 May 08. Adjust flights accordingly.

### 6 May 08 Tuesday

All personnel listed on Attachment A under NMP will meet in the lobby of the Captain's Quarters Hotel and be ready to depart to the NMP site at 0715 hrs on 6 May 08. Travel to the station will be rental cars. Directions from the Captain's Quarters to the site are provided in Attachment B. A copy of the schedule for the NMP visit is found in attachment D. All will meet at the old NMP

visitors center on the western site of the site. You will have to pass through the guard shack to get to the visitors center. Federal or State issued Photo ID will be required. The meeting will start promptly at 0800 hrs. After some preliminary presentations and discussions we will tour the area outside the NMP protected area as part of the alternate site visit and the T-1 visit. Activities for the alternate site visit and the T-1 visit will be combined and no separate activities will be scheduled. Lunch will be catered by the applicant. Reimbursement is required. Afternoon activities consist of breakout meetings and possibly some additional site tours. We will have an end-of-day summary by discipline among NRC and PNNL staff.

Team building meeting is scheduled for the evening of 6 May 08 up the street at Pat's. More information to come.

Wednesday 7 May 08

Again meet in lobby at 0800 hrs for travel to NMP site via rental car. We will continue with breakout sessions part of the morning and plan to have an exit briefing with the potential applicant at 1100 hrs. All will attend. Any individuals with conflicts should discuss them with the NRC Readiness Team Manager prior to Wednesday 7 May 08. After the exit briefing with the proposed applicant all personnel (with the exception of the Cultural and Socioeconomic and EJ representatives, T. O'Neil/T. Fredrichs and T. Seacrest/D. Mussatti) are released for travel home, to Fermi T-1 or the Levy C-3. There are no plans for a noon meal. T. O'Neil and T. Fredrichs will travel to Albany to meet with the SHPO and D. Mussatti and T. Seacrest will meet with local officials Wednesday afternoon and Thursday 8 May 08.

\* Just so you don't sound like a complete outsider make sure you pronounce Ginna properly. Ginna does not sound like the liquor "gin" or the common name "jean" with an "a" like the "a" in hay at the end. Instead it sounds the same as the "gin" in begin with an "a" at the end like the "a" in hay.
