The Louisiana Department of Natural Resources, Coastal Management Division, has recently learned of the referenced application for the import of potentially radioactive materials. One of the alternatives under consideration is to import these materials through the Port of New Orleans.

Louisiana has determined that licenses and permits issued by the Nuclear Regulatory Commission for processing and disposal of nuclear waste in the Louisiana Coastal Zone (including transportation to processing or disposal sites) are permits for activities which may affect the coastal zone. Pursuant to Section 307(c)(3)(A) of the Coastal Zone Management Act of 1972, as amended, this proposed activity is subject to review for consistency with the approved Louisiana Coastal Resources Program (LCRP). No Federal license or permit may be issued for this project until the applicant has provided this office with a copy of their Federal permit application, and a statement that they certify that the referenced project will be conducted in a manner consistent with the Louisiana Coastal Resources Program.

Processing of the above referenced application will proceed upon receipt of the requested information. Please refer to the above Consistency Application number when responding to this letter.
