Delete: Peter Barbounis as an Assistant RSO.

Add: Leanne Green and Jamie Boulet as Assistant RSOs.

Leanne Green, A.S., B.S., [Animal Science, Rutgers], Senior Scientist at EPSL Worked as a Laboratory Technician for Lab Support at DNX, for AeroTech at Bristol Myers Squibb, and for Kelly Scientific, as a Veterinary Technician at Novartis. She was also a Toxicology Scientist at Novartis Pharmaceuticals. At Eurofins Product Safety Laboratories (EPSL), she is the Chemical Hygiene Officer, and has participated in the Laboratory Radiation Safety Training. Leanne will be taking the 40 hour Radiation Safety Officer Course.

Jamie M. Boulet, A.S., Bachelor-Equivalent Degree, (DEC) [Health Sciences, Vanier College], RLATR, CALAS-Senior Scientist at EPSL Jamie has worked as a Research Technician Level II for Astra Zeneca R&D Montreal, a Scientist at Purdue Pharma LLP, a Senior Associate Scientist at Johnson & Johnson Pharmaceutical R&D. Jamie received company sponsored Radiation Safety Training yearly at each of his employers.

At Purdue Pharma (2001-2004), Jamie was responsible for the operation and Maintenance of a GE Lunar PIXImus Bone Mineral Densitometer which used dual energy x-ray absorptiometry (DEXA) to measure bone density in small

animals. He assisted in the QC checks to insure the proper functioning of the unit and measured the radiation scatter in the room at regular intervals.

Item 8 – Training for Individuals Working in or Frequenting Restricted Areas.

Delete: Peter Barbounis as an Authorized User.

Add: William Gravelle, M.S., [Agronomy, Virginia Tech]- Study Director at EPSL Worked with C-14 and H-3 labeled experimental pesticides for environmental fate and plant metabolism experiments. (0-2 mCi/samples) at FMC Corporation 1992-2006. Received yearly Radiation Training to 2006.

Austin Xu, Ph.D., [Chemistry, Univ.of Saskatchewan]- Study Director at EPSL Worked with Nuclear fuel treatment mainly U, PU and fission fragments at the China Institute of Technology in China for 6 years and 1-2 mCi H-3 and C-14 labeled compounds at Chemtura in Middleburg, CT from 2000 to 2005. Received yearly Radiation Training to 2005.

Please note: as per our agreement with the NRC, Radiation Safety Training will be conducted prior to the handling of radioactive materials.
