

Under 50.47 Emergency Plans, modify (8) as follows:

(8) Adequate emergency facilities, communications and equipment to support the emergency response, such as the EOF, TSC, Incident Command Post and Staging Area are provided and maintained. (this change should also be made to item (4) on page 5 of 18 along with the deletion of the word onsite)

Under IV Content of Emergency Plans add the following

A. Organization

10 A description of the onsite response capabilities to comply and interface with organizations using the Incident Command system. This includes all facets of ICS as identified in the National Incident Management System. This should include those positions within the Emergency Organization that are trained in advanced Incident Command aspects.

Under C. Activation of Emergency Organization, add:

3. An applicant or licensee shall establish and maintain the capability to assess, assist in activation, develop and maintain procedural requirements and equipment maintenance of Incident Command Post(s) and staging area(s) licensee owned equipment and communication devices.

Under E. Emergency Facilities and equipment , add:

9c - , the incident command post and staging area,

10. Procedures, facilities and communication protocols are developed and in place for Incident Command Posts. These IC Posts are identified in licensee plans along with the equipment necessary for activation and communication to onsite and offsite senior staff.

11. Staging area(s) for offsite responders are pre-designated and procedures and communications capabilities are in place for use of these staging area(s).

F. Training

x. Senior ERO staff that are trained in advanced National Incident Command System Courses such as ICS-300 and ICS-400

On page 17 of 18 change 2.j to “Each biennial exercise should proceed to the General Emergency level.”

I. Onsite Protective Actions During Hostile Action Events, modify as follows:
“The range of protective actions developed for the plume exposure pathway EPZ emergency workers must include specific actions to protect onsite personnel and those offsite personnel that respond onsite during hostile action events.”
