SUBJECT: TELCONFERENCE SUMMARY REGARDING POINT BEACH NUCLEAR  
PLANT PROPOSED POWER UPRATE AND ALTERNATE SOURCE TERM  
AMENDMENT

On June 5, 2008, the Acting Division Director for the Division of Operator Reactor Licensing (DORL) notified the Vice President for Technical Services at Florida Power and Light Company (FP&L) that its plan to submit in November 2008, an extended power uprate (EPU) for Point Beach Units 1 and 2 that assumes approval of an alternate source term (AST) amendment would not meet Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) acceptance criteria. The AST amendment is scheduled to be submitted in September 2008. Acceptance review criteria specifies that an amendment request should not be accepted for NRC review and approval until all prerequisite amendment requests have been reviewed and approved by the NRC. The AST amendment also resolves a long-standing control room habitability safety issue.
