During a meeting with the NRC staff on May 15, 2008, the Nuclear Energy Institute (NEI) requested that NRC close out the requests in the NRC letter referenced above if the addressee responds with an unprioritized list of reports that are under development and their prospective submittal dates. NEI requested that NRC defer the collection of prioritization and usage data pending further discussion with the NEI Topical Report Team, a subgroup of the NEI Licensing Action Task Force. The NEI Topical Report Team is engaged in a series of public meetings with the NRC staff with the goal of improving the overall topical report process.
