
Under penalty of perjury, Julia Stubblebine declares as follows:






Under penalty of perjury, John Kimmons declares as follows:

1. My name is William Ross McCluney. I am a member of the Southern Alliance for Clean Energy.

2. I live at 3517 Elderview Dr., Chattanooga, TN 37419 for approximately eight months of the year and at 219 Johnson Ave., Cape Canaveral, FL 32920 for approximately four months of the year. I am registered to vote in Florida and have a Florida driver's license but I own the home in Chattanooga where my wife and I reside and I pay state and county property taxes as well as sales taxes in Tennessee.

My Chattanooga home lies within 50 miles of the site in Jackson County, Alabama, owned by the Tennessee Valley Authority for which it has applied to the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission ("NRC") for Combined Construction and Operations License for the construction of two new nuclear power plants.

3. Based on historical experience with nuclear reactors to date, I believe that these facilities are inherently dangerous. Therefore, construction two new nuclear reactors so close to my home could pose a grave risk to my health and safety. In particular, I am concerned that if an accident involving atmospheric release of radiological material were to occur, I could be killed or become very ill. I am also concerned about the threats of accidental releases of fuel and radioactive wastes during transport to and from the site and fear that these could also injure myself, my family, and my friends living and traveling in the areas affected. I am further convinced that this nuclear expansion plant is unnecessary. TVA's projections of future need are inflated above what can be expected, based on recent history and the real possibility of energy efficiency, energy conservation, and use of renewable energy sources more than displacing any projected increase in electricity demand in the TVA service territory. In consequence, I object to TVA's planned nuclear expansion in the vicinity of my home and elsewhere.






