Our primary contacts were Harry Calley, Jr., consultant from N.U.S., and Robert Allen, chemical engineer in charge of the polymer irradiation processing facility.

Most of the facility was constructed according to the applicant's application, however, the following discrepancies were noted:

1. The audible alarms of the Vamp radiation monitors were not at all distinguishable over the background noise around the general pool area when tested. (b)(2)High


