Please allow this letter to serve as notice that Medi-Physics, Inc., dba GE Healthcare wishes to make the following changes to the above referenced license:

1. Increase the maximum possession limit of Iodine-131 noted in Condition 8E of the existing radioactive material license to 3.0 Curies (111 GBq). The increase in the Iodine-131 maximum possession limit is warranted due to the growing demands of the nuclear pharmacy business in the area.




