2. **Disposal Limits:** No solid radioactive material shall be disposed of without written authorization from the RSO. Radioactive waste will be held in storage for pick-up and disposal by the Health Physics Office. Specific types and quantities of liquid radioactive materials may be disposed through the "hot sink" in accordance with the SOP.

3. Authorized Use:

a. A through E (as noted in paragraph 1). Medical diagnosis and therapy as described in 10 CFR 35.100, 35.200, 35.300, 35.500 and TB Med 525 Appendix C. Research in humans as approved by the Food and Drug Administration (FDA) or by a Radioactive Drug Research Committee approved by the FDA and the Department of the Army. 10CFR 31.11 invitro, laboratory testing and instrument calibrations.

b. The following personnel have been approved by the EAMC Radiation Safety Committee (RSC) to work with radioactive material under this authorization. Administration or prescription of radiopharmaceuticals or radiation from radioactive material to humans for the following procedures shall only be performed under the direct supervision of the principal authorized user listed below.
