SUBJECT: SUMMARY OF THE PUBLIC SCOPING MEETINGS TO SUPPORT THE
REVIEW OF THE SHEARON HARRIS NUCLEAR POWER PLANT,
UNITS 2 AND 3 COMBINED LICENSE APPLICATION
(TAC NO RD3325)

The U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) staff conducted an environmental scoping meeting related to the review of the Shearon Harris Nuclear Power Plant, Units 2 and 3 (HAR) combined license (COL) application submitted by Progress Energy Carolinas, Inc. (PEC). The NRC staff conducted two public meetings on Tuesday, June 10, 2008, at the Holly Springs Cultural Center in Holly Springs, North Carolina. Approximately 132 people attended each meeting. The participants included members of the NRC staff, Pacific Northwest National Laboratory, members of the public, PEC, the news media, state agencies, local residents, and local government officials. Public comments and questions were mainly focused on the COL process, AP1000 design certification process and schedule, the need for power, water resources that may be affected, energy alternatives, the storage spent fuel at the site (existing storage and from the proposed two new reactors), the ultimate disposal of the spent fuel, and emergency evacuation.

The purpose of the meeting was to provide the public with an opportunity to participate in the environmental scoping process by providing comments on any issues the public thought the NRC staff should consider while preparing an environmental impact statement for the HAR COL application. During the meeting the NRC staff presentation outlined the overall licensing process under 10 CFR Part 52; provided a description of the National Environmental Policy Act of 1969 review process; discussed the environmental requirements outlined in 10 CFR Part 51; and addressed how these requirements would be implemented during the HAR COL review.
