Subject: **Response to NRC Request for Prioritization of Topical Report Reviews  
and List of Planned Topical Report Submittals for FY 2008 and FY 2009**

Reference: NRC Letter dated 3/13/08 - Project No. 694, "Request for Prioritization of Topical Report Reviews and List of Planned Topical Report Submittals for FY2008 and FY2009"

By the letters dated March 13, 2008, the NRC requested that industry organizations provide the NRC with information on future Topical Report (TR) submittals for planning and budgeting purposes. Specifically, the NRC requested that the PWROG provide a list of planned submittals for FY2008 and FY2009 and prioritize current and future TRs.

The following are the Topical Reports (and other associated correspondence) planned or contemplated by the PWROG in FY 2008 through 2010. Please note that this list does not include Westinghouse or AREVA submitted Topical Reports or TSTF submitted documents, only Topical Reports submitted through the PWROG.

**FY 2008:**

- July 2008 - PSAT 4025CF.QA.04 Rev. 1, "StarFIRE Model Report" (This report was submitted to the NRC in May 2008 along with a request for waiver of the review fees of which was denied. The PWROG will formally request the NRC to initiate review of the Topical Report and agree to pay associated review fees.)
- July 2008 - WCAP-16745-NP, "Boric Acid Reactor Vessel Mixing/Transport Phenomena Identification and Ranking Table (PIRT)." (To be provided for information only. Review and approval will not be requested. Draft version provided to NRC July 2007.)

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- July 2008 - BAW-10192, "BWNT Loss-of-Coolant Accident Evaluation Model for Once-Through Steam Generator Plants."
- September 2008 - WCAP-16676-NP, "Analysis Update for the Inadvertent Loading Event" (The PWROG is considering not submitting this TR for review based on feedback from the NRC staff during the pre-submittal in December 2007. The NRC staff stated that the inadvertent loading event is not a significant safety issue and that licensees could implement use of WCAP-16676 under 10 CFR 50.59.)

**FY 2009/2010:**

- July 2009 – "Post LOCA Long Term Cooling Boric Acid Control Analysis – Evaluation Model Scenarios, Assumptions and Acceptance Criteria"
- October 2009 - Large Break Redefinition
- July 2010 - Justification for Logic Cabinets for New Design Boards and Master Relay Test Interval Extension

The NRC letter referenced above also requested a prioritization of PWROG reports submitted to the NRC in FY2008 and FY2009. During a meeting with the NRC staff on May 15, 2008, NEI requested that NRC close out these requests if the addressees respond with an unprioritized list of authorized TRs that are under development and their prospective submittal dates. NEI requested that NRC defer the collection of prioritization and usage data pending further discussion with the NEI Topical Report Team, a subgroup of the NEI Licensing Action Task Force. The TR Team is engaged in a series of public meetings with the NRC staff with the goal of improving the overall TR process.



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
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
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
