Dear Mrs. Cyr:

Morgan, Lewis & Bockius LLP ("The Firm") hereby provides notice to you as the Designated Agency Ethics Official for the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission, of actions taken by the Firm pursuant to D.C. Rules of Professional Conduct 1.11 and Virginia Rules of Professional Conduct 1.11 and 1.12.

As you know, Jonathan M. Rund joined the Firm as an Associate within our Firm's Energy Practice, on April 8, 2008. Prior to joining the Firm, Mr. Rund served as an Attorney for the Assistant General Counsel for New Reactor Programs in the Office of the General Counsel, U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission. In addition, prior to serving as an Attorney in the Office of the General Counsel, Mr. Rund served as a Law Clerk for the Atomic Safety and Licensing Board Panel, U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission.

Mr. Rund has advised Morgan Lewis that, in his NRC positions, he participated personally and substantially (or may be perceived as having done so) in the following matters pending before the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission, including its Atomic Safety and Licensing Boards in which the Firm has entered an appearance:

- Southern Nuclear Operating Company (Early Site Permit for the Vogtle ESP Site), Docket No. 52-011-ESP.
- GE-Hitachi Nuclear Energy (ESBWR Standard Design Certification), Docket No. 52-010.
- Shaw AREVA MOX Services, LLC (Mixed Oxide Fuel Fabrication Facility Possession and Use License), Docket No. 70-3098.

In light of Mr. Rund's involvement in these matters, the Firm has taken the following actions:

- 1. Mr. Rund has been and will be screened from all participation in the foregoing matters. The Firm's File Room and Information Technology personnel have been instructed not to grant Mr. Rund access to the files relating to these matters, and the applicable files have been or will be labeled accordingly. He will not share in any fees attributable to these matters. Moreover, Mr. Rund has not revealed any information regarding the noted matters that he obtained while an Attorney in the NRC's Office of the General Counsel or a Law Clerk for the NRC's Atomic Safety and Licensing Board Panel to anyone in the Firm.
- 2. The Firm has represented the above-described clients in the noted matters before Mr. Rund joined the Firm, as the Firm had a pre-existing Nuclear Energy Practice prior to the arrival of Mr. Rund. The Firm has informed existing clients of the foregoing screens and restrictions.

Finally, the Firm has been retained by the U.S. Department of Energy with respect to its application for a high-level waste repository at Yucca Mountain. Although our understanding is that Mr. Rund was not personally and substantially involved in any matter relative to the Firm's representation while at the NRC, out of an abundance of caution, we have applied the same screen, terms, and restrictions as to Mr. Rund with respect to that representation. *See* U.S. Department of Energy (High-Level Waste Repository: Pre-Application Matters), Docket No. PAPO-001.

I attest that all affiliated lawyers are aware of the requirement that Mr. Rund be screened from participating in or discussing the above-noted matters and representation.
